## PREFACE

This edition of the Replacement list of fiction is a record based on reported practice, not on opinion -- either of a committee or an individual -- as to what titles libraries should replace. It includes titles of fiction which are reported to be actually and frequently replaced by representative American libraries.

On instructions from and with the advice of the Editorial Committee, the editorial staff of the A.L.A. Publishing Department selected twelve libraries in four groups serving populations of from 10,000 to 4,000,000. These libraries were asked to check the first edition of Replacement list of fiction for titles which they would still replace and were asked to furnish lists of additional titles or of titles in different editions from those in the main list which they would repurchase when original copies had to be withdrawn from circulation.

This information was combined at A.L.A. headquarters. No attempt was made to reconcile differing opinions. If a title was included by only one of the libraries in a population group, it was included in the list. Nor was any attempt made to select the best edition of any title. In some cases as many as six or eight editions of a single title are included. Out-of-print titles were eliminated as far as possible. All prices were checked in the 1938 Publishers' trade list annual.

This list is in no sense intended as a recommendation by either the American Library Association or the contributing libraries. It is merely a report of practice. It should be remembered, too, that even the lists supplied by the contributing libraries would be affected by such variables as change in types of population, with resulting changes of interest, and budget limitations.

The Editorial Committee wishes to thank the chiefs and staffs of all the libraries listed on page vi for their cooperation in the compilation of this list.
