NOTE.

SERIES of Cheap Reprints of Books (dictionaries and similar reference-books not included) likely to be of interest to the general reader are analysed in the following Tables, and the books they contain are indexed under the surnames of their Authors. The price rarely exceeds 5s.

The Lists are taken from the Catalogues of the Publishers concerned, and each series is indicated by an initial letter (A to Zd). The key to this alphabet will be found on pages iv to x, where the following particulars of each series are given in tabular form: (1) Reference-letter; (2) number of volumes published (to November, 1910); (3) Publisher's name and address; (4) size of the books in inches; (5) prices and styles of binding.

In the Lists themselves (pages xi to xlii)—

A numeral (2, 3, etc.) after the reference-letter indicates the number of volumes in which the book is issued. Where no numeral is added, the book is issued in one volume.

An asterisk (*) after the reference-letter indicates that the book is incomplete (Selections, Extracts, etc.).

A dagger (†) after the reference-letter indicates that more than one book is bound up in the same volume.

Mere cheap reprints of copyright books are not included, as competitive editions of such books do not exist; but in all cases where non-copyright editions differ from the copyright edition, care has been taken to indicate this fact by adding at length the Publisher's name and the price of the copyright edition or editions.

All modern fiction and *all juvenile literature* are also excluded.

Information as to omissions or mistakes will be extremely welcome, and should be addressed to the Editor of *The Literary Year-Book*. In the meantime it is hoped that these Lists will continue to merit the appreciation which they have hitherto received at the hands of book-buyers among the public and in the trade.
